### 94 PRIME CATTLE

A handful more cattle forward this morning saw a similar trade despite downward pressure on steak meat, roasting joints and the expensive cuts. Cattle numbers remain tight with the larger players chasing supplies at the beginning of the week.

Steer numbers melted away with only a couple forward selling to 287p/kg or £1882 in the lump.

No heifers hitting the 300 pence figure today, saw the best to 296p/kg with heavier females to £1908.

Bull trade was strong with some decent suckler bulls selling to 264p/kg, with heavies to £1890 in the lump. A blistering back and white trade sold to 218p/kg.

#### 2 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 281P/KG

Evans (Curdale) red Limmie topped here at 286p/kg for 658kg or £1881.88, with Dave Roberts selling his Limmie to 275p/kg for 604kg.

#### 60 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 262P/KG

Some tremendous meated females forward with Richard Parkes excelling at 296p/kg for a 540kg British Blue. Second spot was taken by Roger Jordin selling his handy 488kg Limmie to 295p/kg. 658kg bulls from Evans (Curdale) totted up well at £1908.20 for 658kg (290p/kg). Well meated commercial sorts easiest sold today.

#### 32 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 234P/KG

A super run of homebred Limmies from Harold and Rob Pugh stole the limelight at 264p/kg for 628kg with two others to 260p/kg from the same stable. Dan Watkins' handyweight, shapey bunch also achieved 260p/kg for 548kg. Well finished Limmies from Dave Jones stacked up well to £1889.58, with two others above £1800.

A nice run of young Black and Whites from Colin Evans topped at 218p/kg – a real flier.

### **1205 LAMBS**

#### ***Auctioneer – Martin Clack 07977 067519***

A smaller number of lambs forward to last week, with trade easier following the national trend, possibly a reaction to the very warm weather and retailers experiencing slow sales of sheep meat.

Best lambs remain easily sold with meat and conformation meat sought after, selling to 275p/kg for 50kg Texels from Andrew Preece and £137.50 40kg lambs to 268p/kg for 40kg lambs from Pete Kirton, and lambs over 44kg generally easier to sell, although this could be a reflection on finish rather than simply weight. Lambs under 38kg sold to 230p/kg to 247p/kg with odd pens up to 263p/kg.

Lean lambs are becoming quite an issue, with clients prepared to buy finished lambs rather than lean under-finished animals.

A larger entry of ewes with trade generally easier, following the national trend. Large, strong, meated sheep to £167 for Texels from Andrew Meredith, £137.50 for Suffolks from Graham Davies and pen after pen of North Country Mule ewes to £106.

Plain ewes as you would expect an easier trade with customers looking for meat and plenty of ewes being pulled out to save what little grass keep remains. Smaller ewes such as lean Welsh sold for £42.50, Scotch at £54.50 and Cheviots £90.
