156 PRIME CATTLE

Trade remains steady despite buyers complaining how dear the cattle were last week! This just shows how the live auction can drive prices forward, ignoring the cooling influence of the deadweight trade. The overall average of 186p/kg included a lesser sample of quality sorts especially in the clean department. There were plenty of buyers for all types and shapes.

Only five steers forward saw Charolais selling to 210p/kg. The butchers heifers met keen competition with four to 235p/kg, with heavy heifers to £1318.40. Several heifers over 36 months are included in the average.

A keen bull trade saw cattle getting dearer and dearer, with three sucklers selling to 215p/kg. Friesian bulls sold to 182p/kg. Heavy bulls sold to £1402.

17 COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 105.7P/KG

An improved trade with more needed for the three buyers attending. Richard Preece's Limousin cow with shape sold to 144p/kg for 656kg, with another from Dave Bradley to 130p/kg. Holsteins sold to 114p/kg for 678kg with meat from David Powell. Plain cows dearer today unless very very lean.

84 CLEAN CATTLE

5 Steers sold to average 183p/kg – Too few bullocks to satisfy demand saw Dave Chilton selling to 210p/kg for his 560kg Charolais. Hereford x Holsteins sold to 166p/kg from David Cantrill.

84 Heifers sold to average 196p/kg – Dave Chilton (x2), Steve Perkins and Richard Parkes all sold to 235p/kg for butchers heifers. John Hewitt sold to 233p/kg for his fit red Limmie. Heavies sold to £1318.40 for 640kg from David Bradley. There were many more grass cattle forward today.

67 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 176P/KG

Handy weight bulls from Steve Perkins and Charlie Sandells sold to 215p/kg, with 608kg to 215p/kg for Simon Jones' British Blue. Many more Continentals over 200p/kg today. Holsteins topped at 182p/kg from Mark & Rob McCall, with Montbeliarde to 181p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst.

Heavy lambs to £76.74 and 163p/kg for 45kg, with weight realising no less per kilo.

Lighter lambs possibly a little dearer to 150p/kg and hill lambs 145p/kg for 31kg.
