### 138 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward met a very mixed trade with best handy-weight cattle meeting similar returns as did all the bulls but with heavier breaking cattle seeing an easier trade generally. There were more plainer shapes entered this morning which would reflect in the overall average figures.

More steers penned this morning saw best shapes to 230p/kg with heavier bullocks to £1472. Decent demand from the koshering trade for well-finished steers.

Butchers heifers did not quite meet last week's heady heights but sold consistently above 240p/kg with four selling to 247p/kg.

A sharp bull trade with Continentals selling to 224p/kg with heavies to £1659.84. Black and white bulls sold well to 181p/kg and saw strong demand whatever the shape!

### 10 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 81P/KG

Only two meat cows forward selling to 138p/kg and 137p/kg for Limousin and Blues at 842kg and 824kg respectively. Plain steakers to 75p/kg for Friesians at 620kg with boners to 56p/kg for 550kg. Jerseys to 50p/kg for 584kg.

### 83 CLEAN CATTLE

**18 Steers sold to ov.av. 172p/kg** – Butchers Limousins from Richard Parkes sailed away to 230p/kg for 544kg, with 534kg Lims to 218p/kg from Phil Roberts. 610kg Limousins from Mr Tolley took third spot at 207p/kg. 740kg Lims from Andrew Preece added up nicely to £1472.60. 672kg Holsteins sold to 148p/kg from Ian Moreton.

**65 Heifers sold to ov.av. 201p/kg** – A lower average but over-age slips are included at 40p/kg and 26p/kg.

Three Limousins from Jan Edwards all sold to 247p/kg from 496kg to 532kg, with a British Blue 504kg to the same from Mark Jones. 496kg Lims from the Parkes stable sold to 245p/kg, with 514kg to 242p/kg from Matt Bower.

### 55 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 183P/KG

Bull trade was sharp with 620kg British Blues selling to 224p/kg from John Hewitt. 626kg Lims from Gary & Greg Thomas sold to 216p/kg, with 758kg to the same from Roger Jordin (£1637.28). Two heavy Lims from the Hewitt stable added up well to £1659.84 and £1653.60 for 798kg and 780kg.

Black and whites in strong demand to a high of 181p/kg and 180p/kg from Ed Green, with Harold & Rob Pugh selling to £1122.88 in the lump.
