WEEKLY REPORT – 17.01.17

106 PRIME CATTLE

Short of good cattle today with a ring full buyers leaving short or numbers. Best quality cattle easily held values and were dearer if they were not too big. Quite a few cattle too heavy for most requirements but these still found new homes at satisfactory prices.

A small show of steers saw improved prices generally to 221p/kg with £1294 top dollar. Friesian Holstein steers saw an easier trade.

Butchers heifers were a sharp trade selling to 249p/kg with cattle under 520kg the order of the day. Heavy females sold to £1362.76.

Very few suckler bred bulls forward with a strong Holstein influence in most pens. Best types saw a dearer trade to 228p/kg. Black and white bulls were very mixed today but sold well to 172p/kg.

ONLY 7 COWS sold to a very firm trade with no best types entered. Angus crosses sold to 129p/kg, with meat Friesians to 114p/kg for 740kg. Jerseys to 75p/kg.

71 CLEAN CATTLE

17 steers sold to average 182p/kg – 580kg British Blues topped the bullock section for a “deserving cause” at 221p/kg, with handier weight Limousins from John Cantrill to 216p/kg and 215p/kg. Other Lims to 213p/kg from Harold and Rob Pugh.

54 heifers sold to av. 198p/kg – Steve Perkins stole the headlines at 249p/kg for his superb 480kg Limmie closely followed by Dave Chilton’s Limousin to 246p/kg for 518kg. A useful run from Richard Parkes sold to 245p/kg for 472kg, with Blondes to 240p/kg from that “deserving cause”. More heifers with meat and shape were needed today.

35 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 163P/KG

Not too big with shape from IGC Morris topped this department at 228p/kg and 225p/kg – both Limousins. Katie Tomley sold her reared British Blue crosses to 212p/kg and 214p/kg, with a red suckler Limmies to 214p/kg also.

Holstein bulls sold to 172p/kg for 530kg from Phil Roberts, with black and whites from John Cantrill to 168p/kg and to 166p/kg from Colin Evans.

60 bulls are needed each week to maintain regular buying support.

Trade very similar to last week despite falling away nationally at the end of last week.

Best Continental sheep well over 200p/kg to 218p/kg for the last pen sold from Ian Morris. 41kg Texels to 204p/kg from Ray Gregory and heavy weight hogs 68kg at £97.30 from Richard Morgan.

Lighter weights remain easier to sell with 34kg to 38kg to 196p/kg and virtually all pens 175p/kg plus and hill lambs 28.5kg to 165p/kg with most around 160p/kg.

Hoggs over 50kg £77 to £80 although quality very mixed this week. 45kg to 49.5kg hoggs remarkably a little dearer with 46kg at 186p/kg from RH Gregory. Several pens changing hands at 160p/kg to 166p/kg.
