104 PRIME CATTLE

A sprinkling more cattle forward met a sharp trade with tight finished numbers helping to keep prices firm, coupled with a genuine demand for well finished beef. Bull numbers were improved, but buyers are looking for plenty of finish at the moment, with leaner sorts harder work.

Fewer steers than last week sold to a top of 300p/kg for handy weights, with heavy bullocks to £1810 in the lump.

Strong demand on butcher's heifers, selling to 320p/kg with 10 females selling at 300p/kg or above. Heavy heifers sold to £1862.60.

A handful more bulls with a large percentage of Holsteins amongst them. Suckler types sold to a high of 270p/kg with heavy Continentals selling to nearly £1800. Black and White bulls topped at 214p/kg.

78 CLEAN CATTLE

12 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 254P/KG

A star of a Limousin from Marcus Whitehouse stole the limelight at 300p/kg for 520kg, with his 456kg model to 285p/kg. John Cantrill sold his Blonde to 265p/kg with Mrs B selling her Limmie to 260p/kg. British Whites sold to 246p/kg from that "deserving cause". Brian and Dave Whiteman's tremendous run of meat sold to £1810 for 724kg Limousin cross.

66 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 261P/KG

Evans Curdale's run of four Limousins was headed by their 546kg beast at 320p/kg with the others to 312p/kg, 305p/kg and 302p/kg. Harvey Parkes usual stamp topped at 312p/kg for 524kg and others to 310p/kg, 308p/kg and 300p/kg (x2). 538kg Limousins from Rob Pugh sold to 307p/kg. Heavy heifers 670kg sold to £1862.60 from Edward Howells. Small, plain cattle helped to deplete the overall average dramatically.

26 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 222P/KG

Homebred Limousins from John Hewitt excelled here at 270p/kg for 636kg, with his heavier bull to £1907.40 for 748kg. A 696kg Blue Limousin sold to 258p/kg from Dave Preece. Dairy Blues sold to 242p/kg from Brian Williams. Black and Whites were headed by Roger Rowson's 512kg Holstein at 214p/kg with 638kg Holsteins to 213p/kg from Dave Preece
