PRIME CATTLE (RED)

167 PRIME CATTLE

A much improved number of cattle penned this morning and a better trade all round. Whilst the dead weight centres reduced quotations, the live auction held up well, with the overall market average of 181p/kg reflecting a large consignment of very lean and/or over fact sorts forward.

Steer trade by no means on fire but still in front of the competition, with the best selling to 223p/kg and £1462 in the lump. Many bullocks would benefit from further feeding.

Heifers saw a firm trade with ordinary types in plentiful supply- best butchers heifers sold to 249p/kg and £1400 as a whole.

More bulls forward which was great to see with a good ring of buyers to take them. Heavy Continentals sold to £2025 with handier weights to 216p/kg. Friesian/Holsteins were not the very best sample today and sold to 173p/kg.

24 COWS SOLD TO AV. 125P/KG

A sharp trade but with buyers a little more reticent to give the money. Best Limousin cows sold to 187p/kg for 756kg from Neil Perkins, with 672kg Blonde to 173p/kg from Brian Watkins. Well-meated Holstein cows sold to 133p/kg from Richard Hotchkiss.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS ARE REQUIRED

100 CLEAN CATTLE

24 steers sold to av. 185p/kg – A best black Limousin from Gordon Jones headed this department at 223p/kg for 656kg, with handier weights to 220p/kg and 211p/kg for 536kg and 590kg for Charlie Sandells. 534kg Limousins sold to 210p/kg for a “most deserving cause”, with Frank Millichamp celebrating three quarters of a century with his 634kg Blonde to 209p/kg. Many happy returns Frank!

76 Heifers sold to average 191p/kg – Smart Limmies from Steve Perkins sold to 249p/kg and 236p/kg, with Blondes from Martin Faulconbridge to 240p/kg. Heavies from Matt Bower sold to 239p/kg for 586kg (£1400), with 540kg Blondes to 236p/kg from Dave Chilton.

There were several cattle over thirty months included in these averages.

67 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 170P/KG

Increased bull numbers helped fulfil regular orders and helped trade. Well-presented Limousins from Chris Walker headed the pence per kilo stakes at 216p/kg and 215p/kg (532kg and 582kg). Roy Kinnish topped the money stakes however with his four Blondes averaging £1903 to £2025 per head.

508kg Holsteins sold to 173p/kg from Gareth Jones. Several “also rans” would deplete averages.
