Good numbers forward again with a nice show of butchers cattle along with some decent steers. There was however a large run of Holstein steers and heifers helping to deplete averages. Trade no dearer but with best quality holding values up well.

Some good quality steers penned this morning sold to a high of 229p/kg with heavies to £1440.50. Plenty of black and white steers sold to 171p/kg, with customers for them as long as they had meat. There were several lean TB restricted cattle forward. A dearer trade on butchers heifers sold to a high of 248p/kg, with many others passed 240p/kg. Heavy heifers to £1416.80. Best bulls saw an easier trade with more available at this moment in time but with Friesian Holsteins easily maintaining values as long as they had some meat on them. Heavy Continental bulls sold to 210p/kg with black and whites to 186p/kg.

16 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A tremendous trade with a few more cows for buyers to get stuck in to. Meaty Charolais cross cows sold to 168p/kg at 764kg, with 726kg Limousins to 164p/kg. 916kg Saler cross cows sold to £1465.60! Friesian Holsteins sold to 134p/kg for 716kg with no best dairy cows forward.

118 CLEAN CATTLE

48 steers sold to average 183p/kg – Steve Davies stole the show here with his 544kg Limousin at 229p/kg closely followed by a 524kg bullock from Matt & Wendy Bower to 223p/kg. Heavies to £1440.50 again from the Bower stable, with Blondes to £1396 from Frank Millichamp. Large runs of Holsteins and New Zealands sold to 171p/kg from Mr Bell.

70 heifers sold to av. 202p/kg – 470kg Limmies from Steve Perkins hit the headlines at 248p/kg, with Steve Davies in the money here also at 243p/kg for 480kg Limousin. Two Limmies from Stuart Bebb sold to 242p/kg, with John Griffiths achieving the same and first in the ring to boot! Heavies to £1416.80 at 644kg from Roger Jordin.

53 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 178P/KG

Continental bulls mainly on the heavy and/or lean side saw a slightly easier trade with Edward Green's bulls from 208p/kg to 210p/kg. Stuart Bebb's Limmies sold to 205p/kg as did John Hewitt. 686kg British Blue sold to £1406.30 in the lump from John Griffiths.
