199 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward met a mixed trade with the bulls seeing the brunt of any financial pain. Best quality clean cattle were a good trade and held improved values from start to finish, with nice runs of heifers helping to fulfil regular orders.

Once again, there were few best steers forward with the best selling to 210p/kg. More commercial bullocks sold above dead quotations for the week.

Butchers heifers sold to 234p/kg with many above 220p/kg. Good heifers were dearer today.

We had customers for all types and shapes but buyers of breaking cattle were very price conscious.

There was an unexpected larger bull entry which saw reduced demand with very best types struggling above 180p/kg. Bottom end bulls did not see trade quite as difficult.

8 COWS SOLD TO AV. 116P/KG

With 3 buyers purchasing today, we had a fair trade once again with more demand for this cheaper product. 728kg Limousin sold to 146p/kg from AG Kirton & Son, with meat Holsteins to 112p/kg for 760kg from John Rogers. Plain cows to 83p/kg.

105 CLEAN CATTLE

28 steers sold to average 162p/kg. Handy 496kg Limousin from Richard Parkes sold to 210p/kg, with 508kg British Blues to 199p/kg from Rita Corfield. 586kg Blondes sold to 196p/kg for Frank Millichamp. Second quality cattle met a difficult trade.

77 heifers sold to average 190p/kg. Neil Perkins topped the day with his 448kg Limousin hitting 234p/kg. Dave Chilton's 486kg Limousin sold to 228p/kg as did a 506kg model from Stuart Bebb. 466kg Blondes from Brian & Dan Watkins sold to 224p/kg. 566kg Lims from Roy Kinnish also breached 220p/kg at 221p/kg.

94 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 150P/KG

There were 54 Holsteins and other dairy sorts forward this morning. Two super Lims/Blues from the Parkes stable struggled to a high of 184p/kg, with the other to 180p/kg. 582kg British Blues from Julian Aston sold to 180p/kg also, with heavier 690kg Charolais to the same from Mr Breeze. 602kg red Limmies to 179p/kg from Matt Bower.

Best meat Friesian/Holsteins sold to 160p/kg from the Breeze stable.

Larger entries of lambs and the Pound firming against the Euro only has one affect at this time of year; reduced lamb values in some cases as much as £14 per head, with leaner, under-finished and out of spec lambs showing the biggest changes.

This said, finished lambs which ticked all the boxes are still keenly sought after to 229p/kg for 42kg and 43kg sheep. Several consignments still averaged around £100 per head and heavy lambs a similar trade to £131.40/head from Neil Ellis.

Light weights under £2/kg at times selling to 215p/kg for 31.5kg Texels and 205p/kg for 31kg Beulahs.

Smaller ewes at £65 Beulah, £74 Cheviot and £40 Welsh.

Only 4 rams selling to £122 and averaging £92.
