60 PRIME CATTLE

With Mark away, the sun shining and the reserve auctioneer on duty, only 60 cattle found their way to Bridgnorth but, as with most things in life, the bigger the risk the higher the return. Trade was well up with several cattle around £1400, notably 650kg steer at £1410, 698kg bull to £1350 and 646kg heifer to £1340.

Bulls to 198p/kg for 592kg Limousin from J Haycock, with no real shaped young bulls on offer, with heavier bulls from the same yard to 193p/kg for 670kg.

Friesian bulls to 162p/kg from Paul Taylor, with finished Friesians at 160p/kg or over several times. Plainer Holsteins virtually all over 140p/kg.

Steers dearer with several highlights. Mr Terry sold 650kg Limousins to 217p/kg, with Mr Roberts achieving 208p/kg, Herefords to 186p/kg for 624kg and Holsteins 150p/kg from Simon Pennington.

There were nowhere near enough heifers to fulfil customer requirements selling to 245p/kg and 243p/kg for Limousins from Ed Green, 240p/kg from Richard Bebb and 238p/kg Blues from Dave Chilton. An overall average of 208p/kg resulted with plenty of heifers which did not tick all the boxes 190p/kg plus, with Longhorns to 197p/kg.

Only five cows to £1120 for 700kg at 160p/kg from Steve Jones and Friesians to 110p/kg.

Top price this week of 215p/kg for 41.5kg Texels from Peter Morris and heavy weights holding last week's trade to £100.80, with 46kg at 208p/kg.

Lighter weights lacked quality with 31.5kg to 177p/kg, with far too many plain light lambs on offer.
