#### **156 PRIME CATTLE**

With orders slow for best heifers today, trade for these was disappointing when compared with recent weeks but with more ordinary cattle not seeing quite the drop in values as these. Steers were equally as dear as last Tuesday, as were our bulls. Even though trade was less there was a fresh face for clean cattle today.

Shapey steers sold to 220p/kg, with heavies to £1341 in the lump.

Best butchers heifers sold to 241p/kg with less cattle above 230p/kg than we have seen for some time. It would be fair that there were more over-fat and under-finished cattle forward this morning.

Fewer bulls forward saw trade no less with Limousins over 16 months to 210p/kg. Meated Holsteins in string demand selling to 168p/kg.

# 12 COWS SOLD TO AV. 94P/KG

A mixed sample of cows forward saw similar returns, with 636kg Limousin crosses to 120p/kg from Brian Pugh, with Blonde crosses to 117p/kg from Frank Millichamp. Plain steaking Holsteins to £783 from James Tudor at 900kg. Four buyers for cows and stock bulls around the ring today.

### **108 CLEAN CATTLE**

16 steers sold to av. 195p/kg – A cracking British Blue from Ray & Marianne Bason sold to 220p/kg to head this section, with their 494kg handy-weight to 214p/kg. 648kg Blondes to 207p/kg from Frank Millichamp, with 644kg Limmies to 206p/kg from John Gore. Martin Faulconbridge's 588kg Bazadaise to 205p/kg.

**92 heifers sold to av. 198p/kg** – The first time heifers have averaged below 200p/kg for some time, with a super run from Richard Parkes stealing the honours at 242p/kg and 241p/kg, with his 590kg to £1400. Roger Jordin sold to 238p/kg for 496kg Limousin, with 532kg Blondes to 232p/kg from Frank Millichamp.

### 48 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 174P/KG


