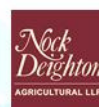

A decent pre-Christmas cattle entry with clean cattle seeing a fair trade without perhaps quite the "buzz" of last week's sale. Bull trade was more difficult with small or plain Holstein bulls and other dairy bred types not really required this side of the festivities. Our overall average of 192p/kg would reflect the lack of bull demand.

Just a sprinkling of steers forward with quality in strong demand selling to 235p/kg for 702kg or £1649.70 in the lump. Best heifers met plenty of competition selling to 262p/kg with another to 260p/kg. Several others sold above 250p/kg. More commercial sorts were also sought after with both fat and lean easily finding new homes.
