Disappointing numbers of clean cattle forward but with similar bull numbers this morning. A dearer trade resulted, with cattle possibly 10p/kg up on last Tuesday.

Our next Red Market will be held on New Year's Eve  $-31^{\rm st}$  December 2019 (normal times apply), so please contact Mark Burgoyne in good time with your potential entries so that we can inform our buyers.

A small entry of steers sold well to a high of 219p/kg, with heavies to £1,526.40. More steers needed!

More heifers were required, we saw best butchers quality selling to 255p/kg, with a few heavy females selling to £1,355 in the lump.

An improved bull trade saw British Blues sailing to £1,432 or 210p/kg, with a top price of 211p/kg for handier weights. Black and white bulls saw a top price of 171p/kg, with several plain sorts forward.

7 cows met similar returns with most cows requiring feeding probably? Simmental cross cows with meat and belly sold to 103p/kg or £772 for 750kg. Plain Limousin cross cows sold to 74p/kg for 528kg.
