96 PRIME CATTLE

A great entry of heifers but with a shortage of bulls, met a sharp trade, with all cattle average 256p/kg. All heifers sold to an overall average of 261p/kg, with steers and heifers selling to £1815 in the lump. Even though we are in the January blues trade looks to hold up well with numbers very tight both in the prime and in the store ring.

Best shaped steers sold nicely to 258p/kg with heavies to £1815 in the lump. More well finished steers are required each week.

A cracking show of heifers saw this first and also the last selling to 300p/kg with seven others in the 290p/kg range. Heavy heifers sold to £1753 in the lump.

We were really scratching around for bull entries with 10 bulls cancelled at the last minute. Continentals out of the suckler herd numbered one today and sold to 255p/kg. Dairy continentals sold to £1617 and Ayrshires to 205p/kg.

Only one particularly anti-social cow sold at speed to a realistic 114p/kg for 608kg.

Best shapes today were from Dave and John Preece, selling to 258p/kg and 254p/kg for 574kg and 650kg respectively. 726kg Limmies from Chris Jones sold to 250p/kg or £1815 in the lump. Heavier steers more difficult to sell.

65 HEIFERS SOLD TO OVERALL AVERAGE 261P/KG

Lot number one from Neil Perkins hit the 300 pence mark for 524kg Limmie, only to be equalled by the last in from Graham Sevenoaks, a Limmie at 536kg. Richard Parkes best sold to 298kg for 514p/kg with continentals from Steve Perkins, Dan Watkins and Mrs B all selling to 293p/kg, Roger Jordin sold both his best finished to 291p/kg. Heavier finished sold to £1752.80 for 626kg from Mrs B, with 670kg Blondes to £1708.50 from Millichamp Bros.

22 BULLS SOLD TO OVERALL AVERAGE 204P/KG

The single suckler bull from Bill Yeomans sold well to 255p/kg for 634kg (£1616.75) with Blonde crosses from Charlie Lloyd selling to 235p/kg for 588kg.
