# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 18.02.20



### **161 PRIME CATTLE**

A tremendous show of clean cattle with over 100 heifers penned this morning. Trade a little easier as reported in Monday markets but not dramatically so. Once again more commercial breaking cattle harder work especially if there was a bit of weight involved. Best handy weight cattle saw plenty of demand generally, especially around the 500kg mark.

No best quality steers forward under 640kg, with the best available selling to 205p/kg or to £1,383 in the lump.

Butchers heifers sold nicely to 256p/kg with several others in the 230p/kg to 240p/kg. Heavy females to £1,368 on two occasions.

A lack lustre bull trade with Friesian Holsteins holding their values more easily than suckler bred bulls. This is surprising with less bulls coming forward at the moment.

Only 4 cows this morning sold to a buoyant trade, with well-fed Limousin crosses to 138p/kg for 730lkg (£1,007.40) and heavier Limousins 882kg to 122p/kg (£1,076.04).

Handy weight 532kg Limousins from John Westwood sold to 205p/kg, with 640kg Blondes from Frank Millichamp selling to 204p/kg. Frank's heavier Blondes sold to £1,383.68 for 736kg. Young British Blues 560kg sold to 200p/kg from Rita Corfield-McGowan. Over age Longhorns (33m) sold to 157p/kg from Mr Stephens at 566kg.

### 108 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 192P/KG

A fantastic lot of heifers which were a real credit to our producers. Considering we are in February, trade whilst not on fire, could have been worse. Half ton Limmies from Richard Parkes stole the honours at 256p/kg with 524kg Lims to 251p/kg from Clive Evans. Handy weight 476kg Limmies at third spot for 'Mrs B' achieving 247p/kg. Two black Limmies also for that 'deserving cause' sold to £1,368 for 684kg, with David Digwood selling 664kg Lims to £1,361.20.

### 35 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 171P/KG

Stars of bulls from Jan Edwards sold to 223p/kg for 574kg Limmies, closely followed by Blues from Ed Green selling 584kg to 216p/kg. Bull trade hard work.

Black and White trade did not slip with Friesians selling to 179p/kg from Colin Evans and Tom Hills Holsteins selling to 168p/kg.

A full market this week despite the flooding and several road closures. Trade, as nationally, a little easier but still averaging a very respectable 240p/kg which would include plenty of very commercial ordinary hoggs.

The best hoggs remain very well sold with customers more inclined to give a good price for a good sheep selling to a top price of 270p/kg for 43kg from Rob Breakwell and a top price per head of £128.25 from Steve Evans.

Trade on hoggs 38kg to 44kg not so different to last week. Those sheep falling outside this weight range would experience a larger reduction.

46.5kg from Richard Yates to 249p/kg, Simon Wadlow's 53kg to 233p/kg, several consignments selling hoggs over £120 notably 52 hoggs averaging 50kg and £120.60 per head.

A very mixed bag of lighter hoggs starting with 20.5kg!! Hoggs around 30kg to 233p/kg and to 33kg Continentals to 246p/kg. 35kg to 38kg Continental hoggs attracted spirited bidding to 269p/kg for 38kg from Andrew Dalton.
