Less cattle forward, as anticipated, saw a lift in trade with some well-fleshed cattle penned this morning. However, they were not all the best shapes, with these more common good also seeing improved returns generally.

Not a bad number of steers forward saw the best selling to 220p/kg on two occasions, with heavies to £1337 in the lump. A sharp trade on retail heifers sold to a high of 246p/kg with many others passed 240p/kg. Second quality breakers seeing strong demand also as long as they were properly finished. Bull trade was good with the best types generally heavier than


