111 PRIME CATTLE

A better number forward especially in the bull department saw trade maintaining recent levels. Some cracking cattle forwards with plenty of meat and finish amongst them. The yard of beasts were a real credit to all producers and sold accordingly. Steers and bulls sold past £2000, with heifers very close to that 'magic' figure.

A dozen steers sold to a top of 316p/kg with heavier steers to £2146.68 and £2061.24 in the lump. Best heifers carried a bit more weight on average today but a top price of 350p/kg was recorded for 520kg with 17 females 300p/kg or above. Heavy females sold to £1940 in the lump.

Bull trade was sharp with heavy, fit cattle easily sold. Limousin bulls sold to a high of 288p/kg with heavy continentals to £2092 in the lump. Plenty of demand for dairy bulls selling to 230p/kg or £1446 in the lump.

Only two cows forward which were both sides of the coin. One ultra-lean Simmental at 96p/kg for 522kg, with an obese red Hereford 798kg selling to 208p/kg (£1659.84).

12 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 272P/KG

A cracking 560kg British Blue steer from Mrs B excelled here at 316p/kg with her second Blue star to 290p/kg for 624kg. A great run of Blondes from Millichamp Bros topped at 299p/kg for 644kg with their two heavier bullocks adding up nicely at £2146.68 and £2061.24. Robert Watkins sold his well meated red Limmie to 280p/kg for 690kg (£1932).

62 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 284P/KG

An absolute cracker at 520kg from Evans Curdale sailed to a recent record of 350p/kg with their 614kg Limmie adding up well at £1940.24 (316p/kg). A run of heavier heifers from the Parkes family topped at 334p/kg for 548kg with Rhys Perkins and Mrs B both selling their best to 330p/kg. Stuart Bebb sold his best Limmie to 324p/kg, with Martin Pain selling to 320p/kg for a handy 498kg.

37 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 259P/KG

A tidy show of bulls was headed by Andrew Preece's handyweight Limmies selling to 288p/kg and 284p/kg. 604kg Limmies from Stuart Bebb sold nicely to 285p/kg, with heavy bulls from Dave Jones selling to 281p/kg with two of his run selling to £2093 and £2083.

516kg Black & Whites sold to 230p/kg from Roger Rowson with Dave Preece selling his Holsteins to £1446. There was a Holstein sold at 276p/kg, but we suspect it was a British Blue in reality.

FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND GRANTS IN 2023

Grants for farmers, horticulturalists, forestry owners and contractors for specific items of equipment.

ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE – * NOW OPEN UNTIL MIDDAY ON THURSDAY 15th JUNE*

The **Animal Health and Welfare** theme, which is now open, includes items such as:- mobile or fixed cattle handling systems, cattle crushes, head scoops, mobile or fixed sheep handling systems, weigh bars, electric fencing and ventilation fans.





The grants are for a minimum of £1,000 and maximum of £25,000 per theme, and are based on set grant amounts for each item. The grant element is usually around 40% of the item's cost, however if the price of the item you purchase results in the grant payment making up a lesser or greater percentage, this will not affect the amount of grant paid, so long as the requirements below are still met.

These requirements include all equipment which is purchased to meet the minimum specifications set out within the option guidance, to be brand new (ex-demo or second hand is not allowed) and purchased through a supplier or manufacturer. All items must also be paid for in full (part exchange is not allowed) and no items must be purchased before a grant funding agreement is offered, although it is possible to secure items with a refundable deposit if you are concerned about supply issues.

The application process is competitive with each item given a score, and applications with the highest average scores then being offered agreements.
