Disappointing numbers of clean cattle discouraged by a slip in values recently. Trade was consequently dearer with cattle back to levels seen 3 or 4 weeks ago. You can see that matching the supply of cattle with the potential demand helps to keep the trade up which is why everybody should book their cattle in with the auctioneer prior to the sale if at all possible.

The best entry of steers for many weeks sold to a high of 265p/kg or £1553 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were a good go selling to 280p/kg, with ten others over 270p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1628.00

Decent bull numbers once again saw a firm trade with best sorts a little on the lean side today. Limousins sold to 244p/kg or to £1776 in the lump. Very few meaty Black and White bulls sold to 201p/kg.

Plain aged Charolais cows sold to 78p/kg for 550kg.

Angus crosses from Marcus Whitehouse sailed away to 265p/kg for 586kg (£1552.90) to head this section, with handier weight Limmies 526kg to 264p/kg from Roger Jordin. A British Blue took third spot from Paul Taylor at 244p/kg for 590kg.

Two of the best from Andrew Bishop sold nicely to 279p/kg + 280p/kg at 468kg and 494kg respectively. A great run from Richard Parkes sold to 277p/kg on two occasions with 5 others 270p/kg and above. Evans (Curdale) and Nigel Lloyd both excelled at 269p/kg. Heavier females sold to £1628.16 at 636kg from Matthew Bower with Nigel Lloyd's two homebred Limmies past £1500 to £1583.12 for 616kg.


