

# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET

## WEEKLY REPORT – 18.06.19



### 132 PRIME CATTLE

**Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603**

With downward pressure on the trade at the moment, best cattle held their values easily and were possibly dearer – especially heifers. With the large abattoirs causing cattle to back up into July more commercial sorts and bulls were hard work but no less than you would get anywhere else!

A very mixed steer entry with more native breeds penned this morning. The best available sold to 204p/kg, with heavier bullocks to £1376.

Butchers heifers met a sharp trade selling to 247p/kg, with 6 others 240p/kg and above. Top price per head was £1312 for females.

Plenty of cheap meat in the bull section, with the dairy bred bulls looking easier sold than suckler bred cattle. Shop bulls sold to 199p/kg with heavier bulls to £1330.

2 cows forward saw British Blue crosses 692kg selling to 102p/kg and Herefords to 80p/kg for 636kg.

### 78 CLEAN CATTLE

**22 Steers sold to ov.av.173p/kg** – Limousins in the run from ‘that deserving cause’ sold to 204p/kg for 590kg, with Roger Jordin and JB Morris both selling to 203p/kg for 678kg and 636kg respectively. Handy- weight Charolais sold to 202p/kg at 546kg from Mrs B again. Hereford crosses from Phil Terry to 174p/kg for 694kg.

**56 Heifers sold to ov.av.198p/kg** – Superfit handy weight Limos from Andrew Preece sold to 247p/kg at 440kg, with Richard Parkes selling his Lims to 245p/kg and 243p/kg. 502kg Limmies sold to 244p/kg from Roger Jordin. Shapey Charolais sold to 243p/kg for 494kg from Roger Cantrill. Quality definitely sold to a premium today.

### 54 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 162P/KG

Trade very steady with only handy- weight (600kg or less) bulls with shape and finish holding values.

Bill Yeomans sold his 514kg and 560kg Limmies to 199p/kg and 196p/kg with John Cantrill selling his 560kg beast to 196p/kg. 704kg Blues sold to 189p/kg for Mark Jones (£1330.56).
