Considering the fantastic harvesting weather, we had a good number forward and it was a credit to our producers that there were some exceptional quality amongst them. Those attending were very well-rewarded with a flying trade throughout, with heifers especially sought after selling to average just short of 216p/kg on the lot.

Best Continental steers sold to 232p/kg and just short of £1400 for handy-weight steers, More well-finished bullocks were required to fulfil orders with Farm Assurance an advantage.

11 heifers sold from 240p/kg and over to a high of 247p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1441 with over 36 months to £1329. Plenty of buyers needed more cattle today – please continue to send.

A firm bull trade with a nice show of suckler bulls and a small entry of Friesian Holsteins. Limousins sold to 223p/kg for 574kg with the heaviest above £1300. Black and whites sold to 174p/kg or £1187 in the lump.

ONLY 6 COWS saw trade exceptional with feisty meated Limousins to 159p/kg or £1377. Brown Swiss steakers to 125p/kg. Overall average 139p/kg.

89 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 15 Steers sold to ov. av. 195p/kg – A super run from John Johnstone began proceedings on a high note selling 590kg Limousins to 232p/kg, with his 562kg Lim to 231p/kg. Phillip Terry's Limousin crosses sold to 194p/kg with Holsteins from Dave Cantrill to 165p/kg.

72 Heifers sold to ov. av. 216p/kg – 14 star heifers from the Parkes stable sold tremendously to a high of 247p/kg to average 238.5p/kg on the lot. 500kg Limousins from Steve Perkins sold to 246p/kg, with 522kg Lims from Neil Dalton to 243p/kg whose 632kg Blonde achieved £1440.96. 36.5m Limousins sold to 199p/kg from Richard Roberts. Second quality heifers a fair trade but would benefit if Farm Assured.
