81 PRIME CATTLE AND 3 CULL COWS

Trade no faster with bulls particularly difficult today. Best quality clean cattle held their value more easily as expected, but averages were 15-20p/kg below last Tuesday's flier! Considerable credit to our farmer producers who once again put some well-meated cattle in front of the buyers.

Decent steer numbers saw the best-selling to 320p/kg for 528kg with heavy bullocks adding up nicely to £1961.

Best butchers' heifers topped at 341p/kg with ten at 300p/kg or above. Heavy females to £1821.

Some tidy continentals forward sold to 276p/kg or £2009 in the lump. Black and white bulls took quite a hit today.

Three cows forward with little meat about saw assured Limmie crosses to 140p/kg for 528kg.

53 CLEAN CATTLE

15 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 260P/KG

A star of a Limousin from Evans Curdale sold for 320p/kg for 578kg, with a strong, tidy run from John Cantrill selling to 268p/kg on two occasions. Faithful Devons from Mrs B sold reasonably on the trade to 266p/kg. 824kg Limousins from Robert Watkins stacked up at £1961.12.

38 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 270P/KG

A stunner from Rhys & Steve Perkins took the headlines at 341p/kg for 498kg, with a great run from Evans Curdale selling to 336p/kg and 332p/kg for 542p/kg (£1821.12) and 534kg. 524kg black Limmies from Mrs B excelled at 328p/kg. Harvey Parkes run topped at 310p/kg for 492kg.

28 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 220P/KG

A lacklustre trade here saw some very useful bulls selling to a high of 276p/kg for 728kg from Stuart Bebb (£2009.28). John Hewitt's fit Limmies sold to 274p/kg and 272p/kg, with Richard Yates selling to 268p/kg. Our black & whites were difficult and struggled around the 180p/kg mark for the best available.

Another super run of lambs from Evans Curdale sold to 296p/kg, weighing 45kg and averaging £130 and 285p/kg.

Heavier meated lambs remain easy to sell with 47kg to 287p/kg and 54kg Suffolk lambs from Tony Davies selling to £142.60.

Lambs under 40kg attracting considerable interest with 35.5kg from Bill Hayward at 271p/kg and Romney lambs 35kg at 266p/kg.
