153 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward, a ring full of buyers and a tremendous trade especially on clean cattle. Finished cattle for the koshering trade were in strong demand as were butchers cattle which sold like "hot cakes" from start to finish. All cattle including bulls averaged 196p/kg with all heifers averaging 216p/kg including cattle over 36 months.

Two dozen steers met a sharp trade selling up to 237p/kg, with heavies to £1520 in the lump.

Some very nice heifers penned this morning sold to a high of 251p/kg, with plenty more 240p/kg or above. Heavy heifers sold to £1372.

Bull numbers were much improved and more buyers purchased as a consequence. Shapey suckler bulls topped at 214p/kg, with heavy bulls not quite the quality of last week generally, selling to £1463.

Meated Holstein and Friesian bulls met competitive bidding to 179p/kg.

10 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A very mixed bag here with well-fleshed cattle easiest sold – the plain end were very lean however! British Blues 794kg sold to 135p/kg, with 740kg Simmentals to 125p/kg. Meated British Friesian cows 784kg sold to 119p/kg. Dexter bulls lean 510kg to 76p/kg.

94 CLEAN CATTLE

24 steers sold to av. 201p/kg – Handy weights from Charlie Sandells sold to 237p/kg and 234p/kg both Limmies with 598kg British Blues to 236p/kg from Neil Perkins. Blondes from Mrs Bason added up quite nicely at 220p/kg, with heavies 800kg Limousin from Ian Morris £1520 as a whole.

70 heifers sold to av. 216p/kg — Gary Thomas stole the limelight sold to 251p/kg and 248p/kg, closely followed by Brian Watkins' Blonde at 249p/kg. Roger Jordin and Richard Parkes' tidy runs were headed up at 247p/kg. Numerous others sold over 240p/kg. Dave Preece's 638kg Limousin cross added up to £1371.70

A better show which helped fulfil orders. Some of the better types were a little lean today but would be difficult feeders. Richard Hartley's two Limousins sold to 214p/kg and 212p/kg both 602kg. 692kg Limmies from Wendy Bower sold to 211p/kg with 554kg British Blues from Keith Evans selling eventually to 207p/kg. Square Friesians from Colin Evans sold well at 179p/kg with another to 169p/kg from Joe Rodenhurst.

The lamb trade slips every week with all sorts of reasons as to why. The majority of lambs forward well over 40kg up to 54kg, with producers looking to weight to get them out of trouble. This only compounds the problem with lambs up to 41kg creating most demand selling to 164p/kg for 37kg from Dave Green, with heavy lambs generally 20p/kg less trading around 145p/kg with the odd exception for exceptional lambs from Ed Bunning 47.5kg at 159p/kg and 51kg at 156p/kg.

Large lean ewes as recent week most sought after with plenty of Suffolk and Texels over £75. There were more Welsh hill ewes in Bridgnorth than on most of the mountains west of the border with meated Welsh to £57, small meated ewes £40 and a large number of small lean ewes £25 to £30.

Rams remain dear to £135 from N & C Perkins Texel and £87 Welsh Mountains.
