Where have all the cattle gone? Short of cattle and trade dearer perhaps 10p/kg up on the week. 14 cattle on or above that magic 300p/kg figure, with anything with meat and finish finding strong competition.

A sprinkling of steers sold to 311p/kg with a high of £1831.20 in the lump with very few heavy bullocks penned today.

The heifer trade was phenomenal selling to 318p/kg on two occasions with 11 others in the 300p/kg and above bracket. Few heavy females sold to a top of £1834.56 in the lump.

Low bull numbers with plenty of underfed types forward. A good level of demand to a high of 255p/kg. Not the best example of black and whites sold to a top of 203p/kg.

52 CLEAN CATTLE

10 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 273P/KG

A super fit red Limmie from Roger Jordin took the honours here at 311p/kg for 578kg, with a great run from John Cantrill selling twice to 280p/kg for bullocks up to 654kg (£1851.20). More commercial steers saw strong bidding if they were fit.

42 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 271P/KG

Richard Parkes was top dog yet again with his best 516kg Limmie to 318p/kg with others to 314p/kg and 312p/kg – the last one 582kg (£1815.84). Roger Jordin excelled here also at 318p/kg for 514kg Limmie with two others 300p/kg from the same stable. 512kg Blondes from Mrs B sold to 314p/kg, with her British Blues selling to 311p/kg and her Limmie to 310p/kg. A 592kg Charolais from Edward Howells stacked up nicely at 300p/kg. Top prices in the lump went to Rob & Harold Pugh £1834.56 for 588kg.

Many more clean cattle are required with supply dictating an upward trend in value.

21 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 224P/KG

A lovely sample of homebred Limmies from Stuart Bebb sold to 255p/kg for 596kg, with others to 254p/kg, 253p/kg and 250p/kg. John Beattie sold his homebred Holsteins to 203p/kg.


One of the worst shows of lambs for many weeks with every other pen made up of lean or under-finished lambs, which are proving hard work, with customers willing to bid up for finished sheep, but avoiding the plainer lambs regardless of their price.

Better lambs from George Evans topped the sale at 270p/kg at 44.5kg and heavier lambs from Wayne Brown, of 64kg sold to £134.40.

Lambs under 40kg attracting considerable interest with plenty of customers looking to buy lighter lambs. Welsh lambs of 32kg all sold over £2 per kilo up to 220p/kg.

Plain lambs traded around 200p/kg, with lean 40+kg lambs the hardest to sell.

Meaty ewes were easily sold, but as per the lamb trade, plainer ewes were not so easily sold, with every market full of lean sheep.

North Country Mules sold to £106 with the general quality poor. Meated small Mules sold to £88 with plain Mules selling at £60.

A large number of smaller hill breeds such as Welsh, Cheviots and Blackies sold to £50, Scotch were £61, small Cheviots and smaller Welsh sold for £60.

Small and plain ewes sold to £25 for Welsh, £40 for Cheviot and £45 for Blackies.
