130 PRIME CATTLE

A sharp trade following last week's improvement but more cattle needed to satisfy this pre-Christmas demand. There was a fresh order for butchers cattle and another for handy weight bulls in operation today, so more cattle will be required next week. The overall market average was 194p/kg.

Disappointing steer numbers left orders begging and sold to 207p/kg for 710kg Limousins. A large proportion of our bullocks were over thirty months. The best heifers were well in line with last week's flier and sold to 249p/kg with two other 240p/kg or above, Heavy heifers sold to £1406.

The bull entry was much improved quality wise and saw a very lively trade selling to 217p/kg for Simmentals and Limousins, with Friesians to 203p/kg. Many More finished bulls are needed to satisfy orders.

24 COWS SOLD TO AV. 70P/KG

A very poor sample of cows mainly being boners or plain steakers. Blonde meat cows sold to 137p/kg for 782kg from Todd Harris with 758kg Simmental crosses to 123p/kg from Tim Madeley. Steaking Holsteins to 98p/kg from Culloden House. The plainest of plain sold from 20-50p/kg.

90 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 6 steers sold to av. 180p/kg — Phil Clarke's 710kg Limousin cross sold to 207p/kg (£1470) with Simmentals to 176p/kg at 582kg and 31 months from Simon Pennington. 724kg Herefords sold to 173p/kg from Robert Charles with Holsteins to 170p/kg at 672kg from Sam Jones.

MORE BULLOCKS REQUIRED

84 Heifers sold to average 204p/kg – A nice run of handy weights from Richard Parkes sold to 249p/kg for 480kg Limousin. 568kg and 532kg Blondes and Limousins sold to 247p/kg and 242p/kg from Jordin Bros. A great list of vendors sold above 230p/kg – see below. Second quality heifers sold to or above expectations.

40 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 183P/KG

A decent sample of bulls saw a much improved trade. Limousin x Simmentals from David Meddins sold to 216p/kg and 217p/kg for 602kg and 560kg respectively. Henry Yates' Lims sold to 214p/kg and 217p/kg for 566kg and 534kg. Rita Corfield sold to 213p/kg for 538kg.


Friesians sold to 203p/kg for 640kg from Ian Moreton, with Holsteins to 182p/kg from Mary Beaumont.
