Trade remains hard work even with a few less cattle forward. Ordinary, commercial sorts sold to a difficult trade with lean, quality cattle easier to place at satisfactory prices. Now appears the time to hold your nerve with big players having to hold their prices as they find themselves shorter of cattle to kill than anticipated. Do not show cattle unless they are at 12 o'clock

A sprinkling of good steers today, but with plenty too lean, sold to a high of 214p/kg or heavies to £1374 in the lump.

Not too many best butchers heifers forward sold to 241p/kg on two occasions, with heavy females just short of £1380. A sharp bull trade, with a fresh face around the ring for good quality Continental bulls. Blonde suckler bulls sold to 220p/kg or £1249 in the lump. Meated Holsteins saw firm demand again selling to 170p/kg, with plenty in the 160 pence's.

ONLY 12 COWS

Lower cow numbers met good demand with all cows presented with some meat. Two Limousin cross cows sold to 135p/kg with £975 top price per head. Farm Assurance probably secured a 10p/kg benefit.

91 CLEAN CATTLE

19 steers sold to av. 165p/kg – A fair trade with averages severely depleted by over-age Holsteins at 80p/kg. Cracking 624kg Charolais from Glyn Breeze sold to 214p/kg, with John Westwood selling to 201p/kg and 198p/kg. 590kg Limousins sold to 199p/kg from Gordon Jones, with Martin Osborne's Limmie to 197p/kg at 640kg.

72 heifers sold to av. 188p/kg – There were more common sorts forward today and the average includes over 48 month heifers lacking meat and non-assured at 84p/kg. Best heifers saw improved returns with Richard Parkes selling 516kg and 526kg Limmies to 241p/kg. Heavier 582kg Limousins hit 230p/kg for IGC Morris (£1338.60).

48 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 159P/KG

More bulls were required with buyers leaving with partially filled loads. Brian Watkins' useful Blondes sold to 220p/kg and 210p/kg both 556kg, with another handyish weight 520kg to 200p/kg for Charlie Lloyd. 596kg Limousins sold to 208p/kg from Glyn Breeze.

Colin Evans' tidy Friesian sold to 170p/kg for 464kg with 462kg to 168p/kg from Dave Evans. Rita Corfield's well-meated run of black and whites sold to 167p/kg.
