139 PRIME CATTLE

With bull numbers returning to normality, clean cattle were in short supply; although trade is definitely not flying at the moment. Some buyers actually left short of best quality cattle today, with wholesalers and butchers becoming more choosey with their cattle requirements. Best cattle were consequently easiest sold, with shapeless cattle having to face the music! Reasonable steer numbers saw tucked up Continentals to 218p/kg, with heavies to £1341.60. Prices on these were more than in line with the reduced dead quotations for this week. Butchers heifers sailed to 225p/kg, with numerous others in the 240p/kg bracket. Heavier heifers sold to £1360.38.

Black and whites were the mainstay of our bull entry and saw similar returns to recent times selling to 174p/kg, with fitter Friesians to £1118 (x2). Continental bulls sold to 206p/kg for Limousins or to £1369 in the lump.

<u>A SMALL SHOW OF 5 COWS</u> but with some good sorts penned this morning. Bazadaise cross cows sold to 140p/kg for 648kg, with Limmies to 138p/kg and 130p/kg. Four potential buyers present today.

15 Steers sold to ov.av.186p/kg — A fair trade for the goods would accurately describe trade here, with shapey Limousins topping at 218p/kg for 556kg from Richard Parkes, with 592kg Limos from John Gore selling to 207p/kg. 644kg Simmental crosses sold to 196p/kg from Brian Whiteman with his 688kg Simmie adding up to £1341.60. Terry Bebb sold 766kg Simmentals to £1340.50. Welsh Blacks to 187p/kg for 494kg from a "deserving cause".

54 Heifers sold to ov.av. 201p/kg — With quality heifers at a marked premium, David Digwood sold his shapey 530kg Limousin to 255p/kg, with 488kg empty-bellied Limos to 249p/kg in second spot from Mrs B. Richard Parkes' usual quality sold to 245p/kg on two occasions for cattle around half a ton. The Parkes stable also sold 574kg British Blues to £1360.38 (2379p/kg). Poorer shaped and/or small heifers more difficult to place.

540kg Limousins from the Sandells family jointly topped this section, along with Richard Morris whose 656kg Limo achieved the same. Very few suckler bulls forward.

The black and white department was pleasingly well supported, with Rob Ball selling to 174p/kg for 486kg 22m old, with James Woolrich selling Friesians to £1118.
