With dead-weight centres pulling money out of their prices once again on Monday morning, the live auction bucked the trend seeing improved returns, with only over-weight cattle i.e. 750-850kg difficult to place and it was not surprising to see a few dead-weight boys showing cattle this morning; let's hope they remember us in future.

Some good steers forward sold to a high of 209p/kg or £1368 in the lump. Best steers were selling well in front of deadweight quotes for this week.

Best handy-weights in short supply and sold to an improved trade with five cattle over 250p/kg to 254p/kg on two occasions. Heavy heifers sold to £1365.

Mostly black and whites in our bull entry with a deficit of handy-weighted i.e. 540-600kg suckler bulls. Limousin bulls sold to 216p/kg (21m) with Friesians to 172p/kg. Heavy bulls sold to £1504 in the lump.

8 COWS met a firm trade to average 111p/kg all through. Young Limousin slip cows sold to 150p/kg and 148p/kg, with older British Blues to 132p/kg. Heavy Charolais cross cows to £1132.62. Meated Friesians to 106p/kg, with Farm Assurance an advantage.

70 CLEAN CATTLE

20 Steers sold to ov.av.181p/kg – Bazadaise steers from Martin Faulconbridge headlined here at 209p/kg for 568kg, with Alastair Beedles selling 560kg Limousins to 208p/kg. 658kg and 622kg Limousins from John Gore also sold nicely to 208p/kg. Dairy bred Blues to 190p/kg from Richard Prince at 626kg.

50 Heifers sold to ov.av. 214p/kg — A tremendous trade on everything, with handy-weight half tonnes from Roger Jordin to 254p/kg on two occasions, with 530kg to 248p/kg from the same stable. 514kg Limousins sold to 252p/kg from Richard Parkes, with two 460kg Blondes to 251p/kg and 247p/kg from Brian Watkins. 632kg Limmies from David Whiteman added up nicely to £1365.12.

50 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 161P/KG

Shapey Limousins from Rob Ball at 506kg took top spot at 216p/kg, with Lims and Blondes from Bill Rodenhurst and Brian Watkins selling to 211p/kg respectively. 622kg Limousins from IGC Morris sold to 210p/kg. Heavy Continentals sold to £1504.80 at 836kg from John Hewitt.

The black and white trade held up quite well, with James Woolrich selling to 172p/kg for 614kg.
