Cattle numbers tight, resulted in a similar trade average wise. Commercial wholesaling cattle sold to a slightly easier trade but still best quality butchers types finding values at more satisfactory levels.

A useful show of steers saw a high of 322p/kg with a top price per head of £2075.

Butchers heifers were a revelation with a top price of 374p/kg and £2050 in the lump.

Only a handful of bulls forward saw suckler bulls selling to 284p/kg or £2074 as a whole. Holstein bulls sold to 210p/kg.
