### 77 PRIME CATTLE

Disappointing numbers forward this morning following the Bank Holiday break. Finished cattle are in short supply at the moment, so our advice is if you've got some, then take advantage of the trade. As per usual, fit, well-presented cattle sold to advantage both in the clean and bull departments, with clean cattle averaging close to 270p/kg.

A small entry of steers saw the best to 283p/kg or £1755 in the lump. Steers over 30 months were not penalised, but with a little fat cover required in most cases.

The heifer trade was on fire, selling to a high of 324p/kg, with six others over 300p/kg. Heavy females sold to a very satisfactory £1735.36 in the lump, with another to £1709. No heifers over 638kg forward today.

Bull trade was sharp, selling continentals to 260p/kg on three occasions with heavy Angus to £1877 in the lump. Black and whites in demand and sold to 215p/kg with several past 200p/kg.

Two cows and 1 stock bull forward saw trades firming with 724kg Lims selling to 159p/kg or £1151.16. Lean 1016kg Limousin bulls selling to £1270.

Steve and Rhys Perkins were top dogs here, selling their best Limousin to 324p/kg for 510kg. Second spot went to Richard Parkes selling to 321p/kg for 520kg, with two similar weight Limmies from Dave Digwood selling to 315p/kg and 314p/kg. Heavy Limmies from John Rogers added up nicely at £1735.36 for 638kg, with clean-bellied Blondes from Marcus Whitehouse selling to £1709.68 for 602kg.

Another large entry of hogs averaging 289p/kg with hogs under 42kg very dear. Best butchers hogs to 334p/kg from Stuart Moss, with quality selling very well, notably 47.5kg from Rob Jones at 314p/kg. Commercial Continental hogs approaching 300p/kg, with very keen competition across all grades and weights.

Heavier hogs 50kg plus to £157, 66.5kg Romneys, hogs over 60kg generally over £150, with 50kg hogs a little sharper for the better sorts.

Lightweights remain well sold, ordinary 32kg Continental hogs 295p/kg and better 36kg Continentals at 306p/kg.

#### **1037 EWES AND RAMS**

Over 1000 ewes averaging £123 for an entry of very mixed ewes, comprising of mainly smaller or lean ewes, which are very easily sold but not at higher prices.

Heavy ewes in short supply, selling to £200 for a very square Charollais ewe from Brionnais-Texel cross ewes to £179 from Holland and Suffolks from the Eastern counties at £179. North Country mules traded around £130 to £140 with a number of warmed up Mules on the lean side for £120. Ugly, fat Dorsets were £145, Border Leicesters £160, Ryelands £160 and small, fat Welsh half-breds £134.

Smaller hill ewes looked very well sold and the smaller and leaner, the dearer they looked. Manx ewes to £109, Herdwicks from a long-suffering good cause £90, smaller Scotch Blackface were £90, leaner Swales £70 and small Welsh ewes £77. Small plain ewes were in demand with £49 for absolute kippers and £80 ewes a remarkable price.

30 rams sold to £254 for Texels from Andrew Meredith, £252 for Texel 'types' and smaller Continental tups towards the £200 mark. Plainer or narrower rams virtually all over £120, with notably a very plain Dutch Spotted at £128.

More ewes are required every week with trade at levels never experienced before, and with Eid approaching there seems to be no signs of trade easing.
