### PRIME CATTLE (RED)

#### 169 PRIME CATTLE

A busy market which was good to see and plenty of orders for cattle. Trade was very similar to last week but with perhaps the edge off best cattle slightly. There were more ordinary types forward which would suppress averages. Bull trade was generally firm and the overall market average was up at 182p/kg.

Less steers forward with quality somewhat lacking. Limousin and Saler x bullocks sold to 199p/kg or to £1255 in the lump. Butchers heifers saw strong demand to 234p/kg with several over 230p/kg, with heavy females to £1229.

Similar bull numbers with some good sorts penned this morning selling Limousins to 211p/kg or £1375 in the lump. Meated Holsteins in short supply sold well to 175p/kg (£1175). More bulls could have today.

#### 10 COWS, 6 HEIFERS & 1 STOCK BULL

Better numbers forward met generally a firmer trade but there were no “headliners”. Limousin 70m sold to 114p/kg from Rob Everingham, with Simmental and Angus crosses to 112p/kg from Tim Madeley. Holsteins to 109p/kg from Tom Clarke. Limousin heifers to 140p/kg. Angus stock bulls 822kg to 107p/kg.

#### 113 CLEAN CATTLE

28 steers sold to average 172p/kg – small steer numbers saw Gerald Kincaid topping with his 586kg Limousin at 199p/kg, with Mike Evans’ Stabilisers achieving the same for 612kg. 652kg Herefords sold to 189p/kg from Mr Griffin. 31m Friesians to 157p/kg from Mr Boden.

85 heifers sold to average 192p/kg – A larger heifer entry was headed by Dave Chilton selling to 234p/kg for 488kg Limousins and also to 233p/kg on two other occasions. 482kg Lims from Matt Bower sold to 233p/kg and also to 231p/kg. A super 492kg Blonde from the Watkins camp hit 232p/kg, with Richard Parkes and James Woolrich selling their runs to highs of 231p/kg. 532kg Charolais added up to £1229 also from the Woolrich stable.

#### 56 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 174P/KG

A decent bull entry both in terms of quality and quantity but with a sprinkling of plainer brethren. Limousins from Steve Perkins stole the show at 211p/kg for 592kg, just pipping 550kh British Blues at 209p/kg from Charlie Sandells. 514kg Lims sold to 206p/kg from Andrew Preece, with Chris Walker selling to 201p/kg.

Charlie Jones’ meated Holsteins easily headed the black and whites at 175p/kg for 672kg.

A packed ring of buyers from far and wide were in attendance for some quality cattle shown by Matthew & Wendy Bower having decided to sell their late autumn calving herd. A top price of £2520 was achieved for a British Blue x Heifer (pd<sup>d</sup> 8 weeks) with a Limousin Heifer Calf born December 2014, closely followed by another British Blue Heifer (6 weeks in calf) with a December born Bull Calf at £2500. 2008 born Limousin Cows with a Limousin Bull sold to £2350.
