

# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET

## WEEKLY REPORT – 19.07.22



### 74 PRIME CATTLE

Very short of numbers today, with combines rolling and extreme heat keeping folk at home. The trade was like the weather – BLISTERING! Everything including Holsteins sold to an average of 254p/kg! It is difficult for buyers to fill viable loads at the moment, so more cattle are required each week.

A sprinkling of steers sold to a high of 291p/kg with heavies to £1825 in the lump.

Five heifers sold above that magic 300p/kg figure, to a high of 324p/kg, with handyweight females selling just short of £1700.

Bull trade was firm with a shortage of these prevailing. No top notchers penned today, however we did see Saler bulls selling to 258p/kg, with Angus bulls selling to £1730 in the lump. Black and Whites sold well to highs of 216p/kg, with Hereford crosses to 248p/kg.

Three cows forward met good returns with deadweight centres pulling prices back again. Meaty Devon-crosses sold to 189p/kg for 720kg with Blue Crosses to 187p/kg for 754kg or £1410 in the lump.

#### 11 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 263P/KG

A great run from Richard and Harvey Parkes topped at 291p/kg for 588kg, with two others to 283p/kg. Simmentals from Will Rodenhurst sold nicely to 279p/kg for 584kg. Charolais crosses from Thomas Farming Ltd added up well at £1825 for 730kg.

#### 34 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 268P/KG

The Parkes family are looking for the combining to continue, as they also topped the heifer department, selling their two 518kg Limmies to 324p/kg and 317p/kg respectively, with their 536kg model selling for 305p/kg. Two Limmies from Mrs B sold in third spot to 309p/kg and the other to 301p/kg. Dan Watkins' quick Blonde crosses sold to 299p/kg for 516p/kg. Rob and Harold Pugh sold their first to 293p/kg with Tim Madeley selling to 291p/kg.

A tidy run from Thomas Farming Ltd topped at 258p/kg for 602kg Salers, with a Handyweight to 256p/kg. Black and Whites sold at 216p/kg from Roger Rowson, with Herefords a great result from Colin Evans at 248p/kg for 520kg.

#### **1545 LAMBS**

##### ***Auctioneer – Martin Clack 07977 067519***

A much better entry of lambs for a very hot day and trade firmer than anticipated, almost 25p/kg up on local Tuesday auctions, averaging 290p/kg with better lambs topping at 330p/kg, for 40kg Texels from Neil Perkins.

Meated lambs generally around 300p/kg, with the heavy weight sheep easily sold and peaking at £162.40 for 54.5kg Texel cross lambs from Adrian Bradley. 48kg Texels from Tony Davies sold at 315p/kg and averaged £150 for 60 Texel and Suffolk lambs.

Lean, under-finished lambs were harder to place, even with increased buying support they were still proving hard to sell.

14 purchasers now attend on a Tuesday to bid for prime lambs.

A very respectable entry of ewes with some auctions reporting very small numbers. Trade was similar to last week, the exception being stronger, good shaped Continentals which sold to as good a trade as we have experienced - £232 for a pen of Charollais-type ewes, £196 for Texels from Pete Kirton and six pens over £170. Generally the ewes comprised of smaller hill ewes that would detract from the overall average. Suffolk ewes were £148 and North Country Mules £130, although the overall quality of Mules would be quite poor. Speckle ewes to £71.50, Cheviots £80 and very small Welsh Ewes £97.

Rams were sold to £140 for Texels, £130 for Cluns and £139 for Shropshires.

## STORE SALE REPORT – FRIDAY 15<sup>th</sup> JULY 2022

### STORE SHEEP

A larger entry of store lambs and despite the very hot weather burning up the landscape, trade would be dearer, up around £4 a head on last sale, averaging £75.75 for an entry of longer-keep lambs. Suffolk x Mule lambs from Keith Jones topped the sale at £94. Texel-crosses from Paul Lawley £88, with smaller, leaner Texels x sheep at £80 plus. Only the very small lambs realised less than £70.

Only three pens of ewes with Lleyn yearlings sold for £120 and cross-bred 2-year-olds were £120.

### STORE CATTLE

A typical Bridgnorth July cattle sale, comprising of a very mixed bag of cattle. A small number of suckler-bred cattle sold to £940 for 360kg Limousin heifers and 280p/kg for 11-month-old Limousin heifers, both from Tony England. Shapey heifers over 250p/kg and 11-month-old suckler-bred heifers from John Lawley sold for 230p/kg or £645. Angus and Herefords sold to 218p/kg, 406kg at £895 from Freddie Harries and Angus heifers were just shy of 400kg and £800
