Very short of properly finished cattle today. Many runs lacking meat and worth pounds more through the store ring, whether TB tested or sold in the untested section. Best quality saw a very sharp trade, with any meated beasts eagerly sought after. No best suckler steers forward saw a top price of 190p/kg or £1246.20 in the lump. As previously stated, bullocks with plenty of time should head for the store ring.

Best butchers heifers met a cracking trade selling to 250p/kg and above on four occasions to a high of 254p/kg. Heavier females to £1345 for 538kg.

MORE WELL-FINISHED CLEAN CATTLE URGENTLY NEEDED NEXT WEEK

ONLY 4 COWS forward sold to a high of 166p/kg for Limousins with some Devons to 136p/kg, as were old Blondes. Many more cows are needed – we are having the trade and above!

22 Steers sold to ov.av. 151p/kg – Some shockingly lean bullocks forward including small Holsteins at 110p/kg which depleted the overall average. Bullocks with finish sold to 190p/kg for 596kg from Shropshire Jones. 538kg Blue crosses to 181p/kg from Charlie Everett.

MORE WELL-FINISHED STEERS NEEDED

35 Heifers sold to ov.av. 219p/kg – There were some lean, grassy sorts here also but generally the heifers were well-finished and met a tremendous end. Richard Parkes' normal quality stole the limelight at 254p/kg for 502kg, with another to 250p/kg for 524kg. Roger Jordin's usual quality sold to 250p/kg and 252p/kg for 538kg and 508kg respectively.
