

BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 19.11.19



150 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers overall forward this morning with less clean cattle but more bulls. Trade held up well to last week's levels but with breaking/wholesale sorts seeing a firmer market. Best quality heifers sold to a buoyant trade as long as not too lean. With Christmas buying beginning to gather momentum good entries will be required in forthcoming weeks.

A nice sprinkling of steers forward but with no absolute belters amongst them. Blues sold to £1332 with Charolais to 201p/kg, all well in line or above deadweight quotas on the weeks.

Some handyweights heifer's helped fulfil high end retail orders selling to 247p/kg and passed 230p/kg on numerous occasions. Heavier heifers sold to £1312.

Bull trade also similar but a few more quality sorts about alongside some also rans. Best sucklers sold to 197p/kg with heavy continentals to £1539 in the lump. Friesian bulls sold to 162p/kg with good demand on well finished dairy bulls.

83 CLEAN CATTLE

16 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 164P/KG

With no absolute top notchers forward a firm trade resulted with Charolais and Limousins to 201p/kg from Mrs 'B', with Keith Tolley selling his British Blues to around the £1300 mark for 680kg. Definitely more demand on well fleshed steers 550kg – 680kg.

67 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 206P/KG

Richard Parkes normal standard sold to 247p/kg + 245p/kg for Limousins around half a ton. Mrs 'B' nice run of Limmies sold to 245p/kg and 240p/kg, with Dave Chilton and Matt Bower both selling to 241p/kg. Heavy heifers to £1312.16 for 556kg, Limousins from Glynn Powell and family. Wholesaling heifers showing signs of improved values.

67 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 165P/KG

A few better suckler bulls forward this morning say Roger Tomley selling his 612kg having to 197p/kg, closely followed by Blondes 566kg to 191p/kg from Glyn Powell. Handyweight Blondes 538kg sold to 190p/kg from John Cantrill. Heavy bulls from John Hewitt sold to £1539 with JM James & Son a distant traveller selling Angus cross Charolais to £1497.

Firm demand on well finished Black and White saw Rob & Harold Pugh selling to 162p/kg and Colin Evans Friesians to 161p/kg.

Only one cull cow sold very nicely selling 742kg Limousin cross to 103p/kg for Charlie Sandells.

A larger entry of lambs and trade easier than last week but still an improvement on two weeks ago averaging 185p/kg. Best lambs to 236p/kg for 42.5kg from Stuart Moss with several pens 225p/kg to 230p/kg. Heavy lambs at 46.5kg to £108 from Richard Morgan and Dorset x from Derek Rowley to £105.

Generally the lamb trade more selective with customers looking to buy lean finished lambs. Over fat sheep much harder to sell although shapely lambs attracting spirited bidding. Lighter weights easily sold with 36kg Beltex to 215p/kg and more hill bred at 204p/kg. Lambs under 33kg to 192p/kg from Haydon Burton.
