A disappointing number forward with some quality sorts amongst the entry along with several more commercial sorts. Trade was good with cattle hanging up dearer than last week's trade and in front of dead quotes for the week. Our overall average of 190p/kg included a large entry of mixey bulls with a strong Holstein influence.

Steer trade was form with the best selling to 232p/kg, with heavy bullocks to just short of £1600 for Simmentals.

A sprinkling of best heifers sold to 244p/kg with many over 230p/kg. Heavy females to £1422 in the lump.

Bull trade was more than fair again with a shortage of meated bulls taking effect. Suckler bulls were much in the minority and sold to 217p/kg. Meated black and whites saw strong demand and sold to 197p/kg.

10 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

There were four buyers today and trade was very good and producers are losing out should they go further afield to market their cattle. You will get paid for every kilo you have produced in Bridgnorth!

940kg Charolais cows topped the day for Richard Pugh at 140p/kg, with 700kg Limousins to 136p/kg from Peter Raybould. No best meat dairy cows forward. Cross bred Charolais stock bulls to 104p/kg from Mr Levi.

77 CLEAN CATTLE

17 steers sold to av. 182p/kg — A super 596kg Limousin from Harold & Rob Pugh stole the headlines here to 232p/kg, with 550kg Angus crosses to 209p/kg for Ray Bason. Limousins headed Phillip Terry's run at 201p/kg for 708kg, with his 842kg Simmental to £1591.38. Simon Pennington sold Hereford crosses to 188p/kg for 650kg with Holsteins to 172p/kg for 660kg from Sam Jones.

60 Heifers sold to average 206p/kg — Richard Parkes' magnificent seven sold to highs of 244p/kg, 241p/kg, 239p/kg and 229p/kg, all around 500kg. Handy 434kg Limousins from Peter Raybould to 235p/kg at lot no. 1, with 482kg to 234p/kg from Matt Bower. 570kg Limousins sold to 232p/kg from John Pain (£1322.40) with other heavies to £1339.70 for 620kg from the Dalton stable.

Second quality heifers were more money today with thicker heifers better sold generally.

47 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 173P/KG

More bulls are needed at the moment with buyers looking for numbers. Again, well fed cattle saw the rewards whether Continentals or black and whites. 568kg Blondes sold to 217p/kg from Brian Watkins, with Limousin crosses to 200p/kg for Mr Evans who was well rewarded for his travels. 634kg Charolais sold to 198p/kg for Richard Pugh.

Friesians for Clive Evans sold to 197p/kg for 612kg, with others to 185p/kg from Charlie Lloyd.
