A few tidy steers forward saw the best finished sucklers to 228p/kg and to £1323 in the lump. Strong demand on shop heifers selling to a high of 248p/kg and more could have easily sold without affecting trade. Some decent quality bulls forward met a similar trade selling to 222p/kg for handy suckler bulls, with heavies to £1324.32. Holsteins sold to a tremendous trade to 180p/kg on two occasions and to £1040 in the lump.
