## 92 PRIME CATTLE

Depleted numbers with haymaking carrying on in earnest and abattoirs full of sheep and losing slaughter capacity with the Muslim festival Qurbarni taking priority. Some tremendous clean cattle forward selling to similar values to recent sales, with best finished sorts easiest sold.

A small sample of steers sold to a top price of 250p/kg or £1539 in the lump. Butchers' heifers sold to 284p/kg with heavies to £1822 in the lump.

Bull numbers predictably less sold to an easier trade with best sorts to 230p/kg, with heavies to £1599. Few Black and Whites sold to 214p/kg.

Best shapes sold to 250p/kg for 596p/kg from Mrs 'B's Limousin, with Edward Howells Limousin selling to 229p/kg at 672kg (£1538.88). **MORE STEERS URGENTLY NEEDED!**

Andrew Bishop took top spot once again at 284p/kg for a 502kg Limmie and 277p/kg for a 510kg British Blue. Limousins from Steve and Rhys Perkins also sold to 277p/kg.
