156 PRIME CATTLE

Increased numbers forward met a sluggish trade except on the very best cattle. With both Jewish and school holidays in full swing, demand seems very subdued, with plenty of cattle still queuing up at larger player's door. Middle of the road cattle really suffered today so please contact the auctioneer by Monday morning with your entries.

A small sample of steers sold to a comparable trade to the "big boy", with a high of 199p/kg or £1354 in the lump. It is not paying to get your steers above 680kg generally!

Heifers around that 500kg mark sold well to 242p/kg, with seven others 236p/kg and above. Heavier heifers sold to £1264.

Bull trade no worse once again, with Continentals selling to 200p/kg on three occasions and heavies to £1387 in the lump. Some good meaty Holstein Friesians forward sold to 167p/kg, with plain boners depleting averages.

2 COWS

2 cows sold well with cow trade easier achieved than second quality clean. 780kg Limos sold to 127p/kg with meaty Angus to 109p/kg at 620kg.

85 CLEAN CATTLE

12 Steers sold to ov.av.184p/kg – No absolute top notchers today hence a top price of 199p/kg for 672kg Charolais from Mrs B. Dave Jones sold to 197p/kg for his Limmies, with leaner Blues to 188p/kg. Andrew Preece sold his 728kg Limmies to £1354.08.

73 Heifers sold to ov.av. 192p/kg – The early birds caught the worm today with the usual stamp from Richard Parkes selling to 242p/kg, with others to 241p/kg and 240p/kg. Handy 486kg Limmies from Roger Jordin sold to 240p/kg, with 510kg Blues from Mrs B selling to the same. Heavy Blues from Mark & Jack Whitehouse sold to £1264 and £1247 for 588kg and 580kg respectively.

61 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 163P/KG

One or two nice meaty bulls sold today with Howard Fish, Roger Tomley and Dave Preece all achieving 200p/kg. Limmies from Henry Yates sold to 197p/kg. Charlie Cadwallader's tidy Charolais tidy sold to £1386.88 for 788kg.

A much better entry of lambs sold to a very similar trade to last week averaging 178p/kg, although the best lambs were few and far between. Top price this week from George Evan for 43.5kg Texels, with the better shaped lambs generally heavier weights to £95 per heads twice from Peter Levi.

More light weights this week with hill lambs 31.5kg to 177p/kg. Lean Texel x lambs 34kg a very respectable 187p/kg and Charollais 36kg at 184p/kg.

Heavy lambs attracted "spirited" bidding with 46.5kg from Stuart Moss to 191p/kg, with plenty of interest for lambs over 44kg.
