Short of clean numbers again, with other local markets also seeing a deficit. Quality sold to a marked premium today with some very lean cattle forward better suited to the store market. Best butchers beasts were very sparse and consequently orders were difficult to complete.

Best steers saw a lift in value today selling to 236p/kg and to £1539.72 in the lump. Second quality and over-age steers found plenty of competition.

Hardly any best heifers penned this morning sold to 249p/kg for 606kg with others to 236p/kg with heavies to £1509.

Bull trade held its own with well-finished cattle easiest sold. Meated Holsteins in strong demand selling to 171p/kg. Continental bulls sold to 218p/kg for handy-weights with heavies to £1277.

10 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS Once again a good trade here with Blonde cows to 137p/kg and Limousins to 136p/kg. Small lean steaking Holsteins to 94p/kg. Blonde stock bulls to 156p/kg, with older ones to 114p/kg.

67 CLEAN CATTLE

23 steers sold to average 184p/kg – Handy-weight Lims 546kg and 510kg sold to 236p/kg and 230p/kg for a 'very deserving cause', with Mervyn Yates selling 658kg Limousins to 234p/kg or £1539.72 in the lump. 562kg Blondes to 216p/kg from Nick Faulconbridge, with Belted Galloways to 217p/kg at 438kg again from 'Mrs B'.

Only 44 heifers sold to av. 201p/kg – unusually, heavy 606kg Limousins topped the market from the Thomas brothers at 249p/kg or £1508.94. IGC Morris sold to 230p/kg on two occasions to a high of 236p/kg for 502kg Charolais. 516kg Limousins exceeded Mr Hill's expectations at 236p/kg, Handyweights to 230p/kg from Simon Jones.

55 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 172P/KG



A very small entry of lambs despite the improving trade with best lambs in demand selling to 221p/kg for 38kg Texels and an overall average of 188p/kg, with heavier weights well over £100 to £107.10.

Meat continues to be an issue with several pens of lean lambs presented which only depresses the trade and are probably worth more as store lambs.

Light weights no dearer with 32kg to 177p/kg however, plenty of hills lambs around 170p/kg.

Without the lean and light, the day's average would be very close to £2 per kilo.

Customers travelled considerable distances to attend with spirited bidding from start to finish.

Store lambs sold to £67.80 averaging just shy of £60, with longer keep lambs looking the dearest.
