Very short of stock again with an improving trade from start to finish. Plenty of orders remained unfulfilled today, with trade set fair for next week, all being well.

Plenty of meat about here without any real superstar cattle. Best types sold to 277p/kg, with fit Herefords to £1694 in the lump.

Heifer trade was particularly sharp with 8 heifers selling at 300p/kg or more. Top dog was 316p/kg with heavy females selling to £1763.

A small sample of bulls saw a very satisfactory result, with suckler bulls selling to a high of 250p/kg with Holsteins selling to 219p/kg.

John Cantrill stole the honours here selling his Limmie to 277p/kg for 584kg with other Lims and Sims to 267p/kg and 262p/kg. 788kg fat Herefords sold to 215p/kg or £1694.20 from Keith Anderson.

36 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 272P/KG

Five out of 6 heifers from Evans Curdale sold above that magic 300p/kg figure, to a top of 316p/kg and with their six heifers price per head at £1762.56 for 612kg British Blue. 534kg Limmies from Richard Parker sold to 309p/kg and with the Parker family not anticipating that 300 pence figure trade sold 2 others to 305p/kg and 301p/kg.

Many clean cattle were sold well in front of expectation today and more are required next week.
