A very well supported Fair with a few less cattle forward, with the numbers of cattle locally definitely down. Trade was very two tier, with strong feeding cattle easiest sold as was the quality end. Small, more ordinary long term keepers proved much more difficult. The shortage or the price of bedding was a main topic of discussion.

Cracking homebred Limousin steers from Stuart & Richard Bebb sold well to £1,090 for 9 1/2 months of age, with Robert Jones Simmental cross steers to £1000 at 19 months. Chris Walkers' homebred Simmental cross steers sold to £965. Headlining Limousin steers from Roger & Jason Payton sold to 231p/kg at 6 months. Hereford steers from John Pritchard sold to 220p/kg. Stunning heifers came from the Bebb's again selling to £1120 and £1020 or 243p/kg.

Feeding bulls in good demand with best sorts in short supply sold to 246p/kg from Rogers, Bagginswood who sold their Limmie to £860. Hereford bulls at 6 1/2 months to £690 from Gary Shropshire.

Good entries forward this morning although more could have easily sold without affecting trade. Best quality cattle probably dearer than last week with more ordinary or leaner sorts a little easier. Good bull numbers helped fulfil regular orders.

Some great steers penned today saw the best selling to 258p/kg or £1502 in the lump with two others 240p/kg or above.

A roaring trade on butchers' heifers also selling to 275p/kg with another to 272p/kg. Heavy heifer sold to £1415 in the lump.

All clean cattle with some shape and well finished easily sold.

Our bull entry was pleasing today with a lot of meat about and also some weight. Best shapes sold to 217p/kg with numerous over 210p/kg. Heavy Continentals sold to £1803 in the lump with 3 others above £1700. Holstein bulls in strong demand to 190p/kg.
