129 PRIME CATTLE

A tremendous trade on well fleshed cattle, with only the few ultra-lean beasts hard to place. Cattle were a real credit to producers, especially in the heifer department with good sorts enabling buyers to get stuck in.

Our steer entry sold well but only a sprinkling forward, with best sorts selling to 215p/kg or £1367 in the lump. More well-finished bullocks required.

Heifers sold to 250p/kg with many other 240p/kg and above. Heavier females sold well over £1379.

The most mixed bag of bulls for some time with best suckler bred types selling to 225p/kg or £1324 in the lump. Finished Holsteins saw strong demand to 176p/kg but plenty of plain also-rans severely depleted averages.

11 COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 80P/KG

A few more cows forward but only one of these farm assured. Non-assured Limousin crosses sold to 115p/kg for 656kg, with other Limousin crosses to 100p/kg (non-FABBL). Farm assured lean Blonde slips to 91p/kg.

77 CLEAN CATTLE

5 Steers sold to ov.av. 191p/kg – Frank Millichamps' Blonde steers sold to 215p/kg and 209p/kg for 614kg and 654kg, with Charolais crosses to 198p/kg and 195p/kg for 662kg and 622kg from Mr Vogel

72 Heifers sold to ov.av. 210p/kg – A superb run of handy-weights from Richard Parkes sold to 246p/kg, 247p/kg, 248p/kg and 250p/kg. Roger Jordin's nice bunch topped at 246p/kg, with his heavy heifers to £1379.04 for 624kg. Forest Vale Growers sold 532kg Limousins to 245p/kg, with Matt Bower selling 490kg to 244p/kg.

52 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 160P/KG

Several black and whites below 100p/kg did not boost the average here. Well-finished cattle saw a good trade with 588kg Limousins selling to 225p/kg from Charlie Sandells, with others to 223p/kg (£1324) from Mark Jones.

An extremely mixed bag of Holsteins saw best types to 176p/kg from Ed Green. Old plain bulls harder work.
