84 PRIME CATTLE – Overall average 185p/kg

A smaller show of cattle as anticipated met a very good trade with buyers keen to not leave themselves short of beef for the holiday period. Everything sold to improved returns and good entries will be required for Tuesday 27th December. Please could you let us know what you intend to bring the day before Christmas Eve if possible.

Only 11 steers forward saw Blondes selling to 221p/kg for 596kg, with handy 402kg Limmies selling to 215p/kg. Friesian/Holstein steers met better demand to 162p/kg.

A decent show of heifers sold to a high of 249p/kg from Richard Parkes, with best cattle “on fire”. More well-finished heifers were needed to satisfy demand.

Bull trade was also sharp with British Blues to 207p/kg, with 712kg Limmies to 206p/kg. No best black and whites forward but well-finished Holsteins were a very strong trade to 166p/kg.

10 COWS saw trade moving in an upwards fashion selling to 111p/kg for 730kg Holsteins. Jerseys sold to 70p/kg for 512kg, with foreign cows not much sought after.

45 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to average 196p/kg – Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to 221p/kg for 596kg (£1317.16). 402kg Limmies from Derek Price sold to 215p/kg. Ben Rochelle’s Limousins 592kg and 586kg sold to 214p/kg and 211p/kg, with Charolais 592kg to 211p/kg from LH Wardle.

34 heifers sold to av. 211p/kg – Richard Parkes’ usual quality sold from 240p/kg to 249p/kg x 6, with heavies from the Millichamps to £1391.04 for 672kg. Andrew Craig’s 466kg also topped the day at 249p/kg.

39 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 180P/KG

536kg and 544kg British Blues sold to 207p/kg and 206p/kg from Roger Rowson, with 712kg Limousins to 206p/kg from Peter Kirton. Alan Griffiths got up early to sell Charolais to 204p/kg for 596kg. British Blue crosses into the 190 pence’s from Ted Jackson, John Gore and Colin Evans. Holsteins to 166p/kg from Richard Hartley. Heavies to £1512 from Tom Clarke.
