182 PRIME CATTLE

We are currently experiencing a massive realignment in prime cattle values. Should this continue spiralling downwards and or/ last for a few weeks, it is difficult to see how producers can stand the terms! Cattle that are out of specification for most customers have suffered the greatest depreciation. However, this will not be the first time we have seen trade slipping in January although, this time the drop is greater than anticipated.

The auctioneer has been selling the prime cattle in Bridgnorth Market since 2002 and this was the most difficult market he has experienced since then!

19 COWS & 4 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 93P/KG

Trade was not great but perhaps reasonable compared with other trade. Best continental cows sold to 134p/kg from Neil Perkins, with Mr Home selling Blondes to £1305. All the Holstein cows were plain types and sold to 73p/kg.

Simmental stock bulls sold to 105p/kg from Brian and Dave Whiteman, with Charolais to 101p/kg from Rob Hartley.

132 CLEAN CATTLE

36 steers sold to average 183p/kg. Handy Blonde x steers from Ray Bason sold to 231p/kg for 472kg. Heavier Limousins from Robert Turner sold to 219p/kg and 215p/kg for 692kg and 560kg respectively. 620kg Lims sold to 213p/kg from Gerald Kincaid.

96 heifers sold to average 184p/kg. A pair of crackers from Jean Kirkham kept the interest, with 488kg Limousins selling to 266p/kg and her 496kg model to 256p/kg. 474kg Lims from Matt Bower hit 253p/kg, with 490kg to 249p/kg from Kytes Nest. Commercial sorts met a difficult trade.

50 YOUNG BULLS SOLD OV AV. 141P/KG

Trade was absolutely bottomless. Once again plain bulls suffered the most pain selling below £1 per kilo in some cases. Rob Hartley sold Charolais and Blondes to 187p/kg and 185p/kg for 538kg and 540kg over 16 months. 750kg Blondes sold to 180p/kg for Charlie Cadwallader at 14 months.

Very good Friesians bulls struggled at 150p/kg from Mark Beaumont.

We suspect the demand for burdizzos to be better than this trade.

The top price this week was 208p/kg for 42.5kg Texels from Max Preece, with several others 190p/kg plus, notably 46kg at 196p/kg realising £91.20.

Quality finished hoggs selling easily however, still far too many under-finished sheep on the market.

Lighter lambs to 187p/kg for 33kg and virtually all over 170p/kg regardless of breed.
