Good numbers forward, with two fresh faces to buy around the ring, but the cattle were apparently too dear for their tastes! The trade however was definitely back on recent sales, with breaking up commercial types perhaps 10p/kg less. Best quality butchers beasts held values more easily however, with good demand from start to finish.

Some decent steers forward sold to a high of 208p/kg or to £1448 in the lump. Well finished bullocks were required at a price even if they were above 700kg.

A nice sample of butcher's heifers sold to a high of 250p/kg with 3 others above 240p/kg. More commercial heifers saw the trade 5p-10p/kg less. Very plain sorts faced cow price.

Bull quality was very up and down today with plenty of small, plain bulls penned. Limousin x Herefords sold to 209p/kg or to £1488 in the lump. Well finished Holsteins sold to 175p/kg.

Two stock bulls lacking meat sold to 70p/kg and 80p/kg for Angus.

John Cantrill came off the combine to top this section with his 668kg Limousin at 208p/kg. 582kg Limousin sold to 190p/kg from David Chilton, with the Cantrill's in third spot once again with their shorthorn to 190p/kg for 638kg. 780lg Blondes sold to £1443 from Frank Millichamp.

97 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 190P/KG

A star Limousin from Neil Perkins was in the limelight today at 250p/kg for 538kg, closely followed by the Parkes' selling their Limmies to 247p/kg + 244p/kg. Mrs B's sold blondes to 238p/kg, with handyweights from IGC Morris to 234p/kg.

A poor overall average with some ordinary goods amongst the entry. 712kg Hereford x Limousins from Graham Johnson sold nicely to 209p/kg or £1448.08 in the lump/ 620kg blondes from Dan + Brian Watkins sold to 198p/kg. Handyweight Simmental from Blaeneifed Farms sold to 190p/kg for 498kg.

Quality selling to the higher prices per kilo regardless of weight. 38kg, 259p/kg and 48kg, 260p/kg. With demand outstripping supply for good shaped Continental finished hoggs.

Once again the overall average would not portray the true picture with pen after pen of leaner hoggs under 40kg, possibly a reflection of the recent wet weather. Hoggs under 35kg sold to 220p/kg for Continental Crosses and more Hill Bred Sheep to 210p/kg.
