#### **153 PRIME CATTLE**

More numbers forward with quality difficult to find once again, with breaking cattle seeing an easier trade all round, by 20p/kg in some cases. Wholesalers are reporting a non-existent trade this week, with price reductions not necessarily helping to shift product off the shelves.

It must be noted that we have been bucking the trend for a long period, with dead-weight centres dropping prices over recent weeks, with loads being cancelled by major supermarket suppliers.

Best quality handy-weight steers sold to a high of 229p/kg, with heavies to £1403.00 in the lump. Second quality steers less money with orders for these very quiet.

Top end retail heifers saw trade at least as dear, selling to 248p/kg with several 240p/kg and above. Heavy heifers above 600kg especially lacking back end struggled in places today.

Bull trade was good, with numbers short in supply and plenty if bidders for these. Best shapes sold to 227p/kg for 580kg, with several passed 200p/kg. Meated Friesians sold well to 168p/kg and more were needed to satisfy demand.

#### 13 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Cows not quite as dear as last week's flier with Hereford cross cows selling to 148p/kg from Roger Tomley at 690kg. British Blue crosses from Gordon Jones sold to 245p/kg for 844kg. 710kg Holsteins sold to 115p/kg from Charlie Lloyd. Highland bulls to 70p/kg from Mr Austin.

#### **111 CLEAN CATTLE**

**38 steers sold to average 181p/kg** – A pair of Limousins from Charlie Sandells headed this section at 229p/kg and 221p/kg for 556kg and 564kg. 716kg Blondes from Millichamp Bros sold to 196p/kg (£1403.36). Second quality steers a stickier trade.

**73** heifers sold to av. 192p/kg – Richard Parkes' cracking run of Continentals sold to 248p/kg, 245p/kg, 242p/kg (x2) and 240p/kg, all handy-weights. Roger Jordin's 490kg Limmies also achieved 240p/kg, with British Blues to 237p/kg from Robert Hartley. Commercial breakers less money.
