## 140 PRIME CATTLE

Some tremendous cattle forward but with not too much "go" in the trade. Lack of wholesale and/or retail demand is fuelling a backlog of cattle, so our advice is to keep in close contact with the auctioneers to match supply to customer requirement.

It took a good steer to make 200p/kg today with stars selling to 227p/kg, with heavies to £1421.36.

Butchers heifers were a real credit to producers but with none above 246p/kg such is butcher demand for the time-being. Well-fleshed females generally in strongest demand throughout, with all markets reporting lower values for both Continentals and black and whites.

Shapey suckler bulls sold to 204p/kg, with heavies to £1403. Holsteins to 163p/kg.

## 5 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Cows in demand selling to 134p/kg for Farm Assured Limousins at 678kg. Blonde stock bulls to 117p/kg for 996kg.
