162 PRIME CATTLE

A few more clean cattle forward and a flying trade on these, and some 20p/kg in front of the competition. With some deadweight centres taking 5 pence per kilo out of their prices yesterday morning, this was a satisfactory result. It must be noted that there were several over thirty month cattle forward and several better suited to the stores.

Hardly any best steers forward which sold to 211p/kg or £1352 in the lump. Plenty of Friesian/Holstein bullocks mainly over age sold well but would deplete averages.

A super-sonic trade on butchers heifers with almost more bidders than cattle! Very dear – selling to 252p/kg with more cattle 240p/kg or more than last week. There was a fresh face around the ring, Heavier heifers to £1335.84.

Bull trade was a little lack-lustre with one main buyer not wanting cattle. Best sucklers sold to 216p/kg, with less bulls above 200p/kg than last week. Friesian bulls met a similar go to last week to a high of 169p/kg. Heavy Holsteins less money generally.

ONLY 7 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Three purchasers for eight beasts! Best meat Saler cross cows sold to 143p/kg from Tom Howells, with meaty Holsteins to 116p/kg from Robert McCall. The remainder cows were on the lean-side. Black Limousin bulls to 125p/kg from Keith Truslove.

98 CLEAN CATTLE

25 steers sold to av. 173p/kg – Harold & Rob Pugh stole the honours here with their 554kg Limousin selling to 211p/kg. 650kg Limousin crosses from Andrew Nicholls sold to 208p/kg, with Welsh Blacks to 196p/kg from Paul Taylor, with Terrance Bebb achieving the same for his 686kg Limousin. Friesian steers 177p/kg from Mr Boden. Hereford steers to 171p/kg from Dave Cantrill. Many bullocks were over thirty months today. Two Dexters are included in the average.

73 heifers sold to av. 207p/kg — Roger Jordin's magnificent seven were headed by his 492kg Limousin at 252p/kg. Other Lims from Ian Morris sold to 247p/kg for 528kg with Richard Parkes selling to 246p/kg (x2) and 245p/kg. Dave Chilton sold to 242p/kg. 468kg Blondes to 240p/kg from Brian Watkins. Hereford cross heifers to 179p/kg from Mary Beaumont.

64 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 173P/KG

As stated earlier, trade a little steadier but the people with the right bulls i.e. not too old, big or lean had the trade – the others were harder to place.

Matt Bower's 628kg and 596kg Limousins sold to 216p/kg and 211p/kg. Blondes from Brian Watkins at 540kg sold to 210p/kg, with Lims to the same from Roger Tomley. Two Limousins
