Short of cattle for the customers! Trade is turning despite the difficult market conditions at present but with the supermarkets trying to keep a lid on it. Fresh buyer support around. Consequently strong bidding around the ring on all shapes and sizes with many orders left short of cattle.

No very best steers forward met a great trade selling to 214p/kg or £1326 in the lump. More steers of whatever weight are required.

A fantastic show of heifers saw a headliner of 262p/kg with others to 261p/kg and 260p/kg. Loads of females over 240p/kg, hence a fantastic heifer average of 224p/kg. Heavier heifers to £1411 in the lump.

Nowhere near enough bulls with trade following on from recent sales without perhaps the real bite in the clean trade. Continentals sold to 222p/kg on two occasions with heavies to £1432 at 25m. Black and whites were a poorer sample with several New Zealanders selling well to 177p/kg with a few below 150p/kg.

#### 7 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV 116P/KG

Definitely not the smartest sample saw a Limousin slip to 133p/kg at 568kg with Blue Friesians to 128p/kg. Heavy Holsteins sold nicely to 119p/kg at 878p/kg. 4 buyers looking for cows. More Cows required next week please!
