A fair entry once again with plenty of well-finished cattle forward. Trade remained similar with both wholesalers and butchers saying things are quiet and sales are slow. The best butchers cattle were definitely not the quality of last week, hence nothing 250p/kg or more. Breaking cattle more than in line with dead quotes for the week.

Some good meaty steers forward saw the best selling to 221p/kg or to £1421 in the lump.

Handy-weight butchers heifers topped at 249p/kg, with five 240p/kg or above. Heavier females to £1338.

A better sample of bulls forward saw Continentals to 215p/kg, with heavier bulls no dearer to £1308.54. Black and whites saw improved values selling to 179p/kg and to £1135 in the lump.

ONLY 4 COWS forward saw a livelier trade for once with three producers. Best suckler cows saw 652kg Limousin crosses selling to 145p/kg (£945.40). Plain cows hard work.

22 Steers sold to ov.av.183p/kg - Shapey Lims from Richard Parkes sold to 221p/kg, with handier weights (506kg) to 217p/kg from Derek Pugh. 700kg Blondes added up for Frank Millichamp at £1421, with John Cantrill's 696kg Limousin selling to £1398.46.

69 Heifers sold to ov.av. 203p/kg – 480kg Limousins from Forest Vale Growers headed the day at 249p/kg, with another to 244p/kg. Richard Parkes took second spot at 245p/kg for 528kg Limmie. Roger Jordin also sold his best today to 240p/kg for 508kg. Light-weights from the Rayboulds saw 456kg Limousins selling to 240p/kg also, with 504kg and 460kg Lims from "a very deserving cause" achieving 239p/kg and 238p/kg respectively.

55 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 172P/KG

Best types from Ed Green and Brian Watkins topped at 215p/kg, with handy-weight Lims to 212p/kg from Howard Mold and his Parthenais to 211p/kg for 532kg.

Julian Aston topped the black and white section at 179p/kg (£1134.86) with Ed Green selling Friesians to 170p/kg.
