A small sample of bulls as anticipated with three regular orders not in gear! Suckler bulls were not the cream today and sold to 238p/kg. Black and white bulls more difficult, selling to 180p/kg. Strong demand on the three cows presented with Hereford and Limousin crosses selling to 140p/kg or £1126 in the lump.
