129 PRIME CATTLE

With a short week ahead as Easter fast approaches, fewer cattle were forward. Best quality cattle that were not too big and/or fat easily held values but with heavier, more commercial sorts finding trade very much two tier. All dead-weight centres reduced their quotations for this week also and we are still treading water as the trade continues to ease.

A decent show of bullocks saw the best available to 185p/kg or £1246.00 in the lump. Best bullocks over 640kg not in string demand and those over 700kg tricky.

Retail heifers again easiest placed selling to 247p/kg with heavy females seeing more consistent demand up to £1383 per head. Plenty of buyers for bulls with five men wishing to purchase. Trade extremely flat with best sucklers to 200p/kg and black and white bulls less money to 155p/kg. Increased buyer support promised next week.

ONLY 12 COWS

Only 12 cows forward saw similar returns with meated Limousin cows to 131p/kg, with slip Friesians to 115p/kg. More cows both assured and non-assured could have been sold to advantage.

84 CLEAN CATTLE

28 steers sold to av. 169p/kg – Trade fairly pedestrian with several over-agers and Holstein bred cattle included. Two Limousins from Gerald Kincaid both achieved 185p/kg, as did Alastair Beedles for his 614kg Limmie. 554kg Simmentals sold to 182p/kg from Brian & Dave Whiteman.

56 heifers sold to av. 187p/kg – A big gap between the best and also rans today. Richard Parkes' normal quality sold passed 240p/kg on three occasions to 247p/kg for 486kg. 516kg sold to 239p/kg from Dave Chilton, with Chris Davies selling 470kg Limmies to 233p/kg.

45 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 149P/KG

Not many best bulls forward and trade lethargic, hence the above average.

Shapey Limousins from Stuart Bebb sold to 200p/kg for 614kg, with heavier but super quality Blues and Blondes to 189p/kg and 188p/kg from Charlie Cadwallader. Black Limmies from Henry Yates both achieved 186p/kg.

Black and whites sold to 155p/kg from Rob Ball, with Peter Jones selling to 154p/kg.

Another large entry of hogs averaging 192.7p/kg to 217p/kg from RH Gregory with heavier hogs a little easier although still over £100 to £104.40. Trade on commercial export hogs held throughout the sale with a number of higher prices in the last third of the sale.

Under-finished hogs are beginning to creep into the red market, with store hogs still in demand. It makes no sense to sell lean hogs in a red market, with Friday store sales seeing a consignment of 253 Suffolk x Mules averaging £73.50.

Smaller hill breeds with finish remain sought after on a Tuesday with 31.5kg from Rob Rose at 191p/kg.
